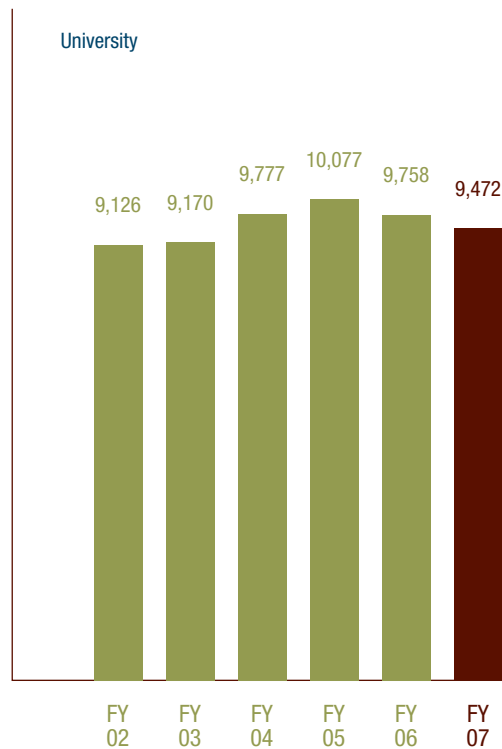


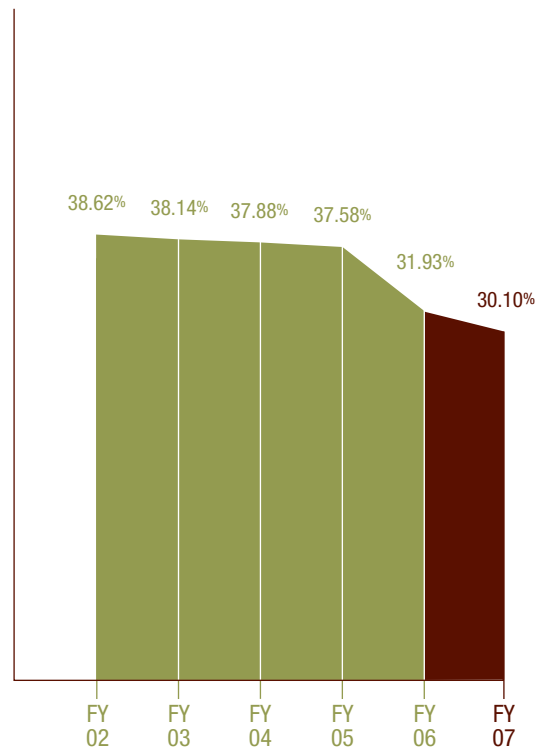
Giving Participation

Total Donors



A total of **9,472** donors – alumni, parents, friends, corporations, foundations and others – gave their support to the College of Arts & Sciences, the School of Theology-Seminary and the Hill Museum & Manuscript Library in 2006-07.

Giving Percentage



The undergraduate alumni giving participation rate in 2006-07 was **30.10%**. Saint John's participation rate has declined in recent years, but it is still very competitive with that of peer schools – our goal is to consistently reach 40% in alumni giving participation.
